Guidelines for the Country Store

Please read this entire letter to find the information that pertains to you!

If you are bringing frozen food:

All frozen items need to be brought to the school frozen ahead of time (for at least 6 hours). Delivery to the concession stand behind the school will be on Monday, October 26th from 7:15 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. Drive to the back and volunteers will take your items from the car so you won't even have to get out! Please include a recipe with baking instructions taped to the item.

Soups/Stews/Sauces need to be in throw-away containers that can be frozen and then placed in a Ziploc bag along with preparation instructions.

Casseroles need to be in foil throw-away pans (please do not use the clear raised lids – we cannot stack with these), then wrapped in foil, and placed in a Ziploc bag along with preparation instructions. Recommended sizes are 8x8 cake pan or 11 ¾ x 9 x 2 lasagna pan. Preparation instructions should include the following: name of the cook, name of the dish, cooking temp./time, serving size and date. If your item is purchased from a caterer, put your name and "prepared by caterer" on the instructions. A country store label will be placed on the item when it is turned in.

If you are bringing dry goods:

Cakes, pies, brownies, cookies, and cheese straws need to be labeled by the cooks themselves with the name, item and date. Also, go ahead and separate brownies/cookies (about 2 large per bag) and cheese straws (about a dozen or so) into Ziploc bags for easy pricing. These items must be delivered to the TROPHY ROOM in the old gym on Monday, Oct 26th from 7:15 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. We will have volunteers out front so that you can drop your items as you come thru the carpool line!

PLEASE REMEMBER: it is very important that these be delivered on time so our workers have time to log the food items and place them in the appropriate areas.

PLEASE REMEMBER - NO REFRIGERATED ITEMS!
